

# Micro Switch

MH-S220-EU

#### Introduction

MCOHome Micro Switch MH-S220-EU is a Z-Wave enabled module that can be set in existing in-wall switches. It supports basic command class, and also can act as a repeater in Z-Wave network. This product can be included and operated in any Z-Wave network with other Z-Wave certified devices from any other manufacturers.


### **Installation Instructions**

#### IMPORTANT:

- A qualified electrician with the understanding of wiring diagrams and knowledge of electrical safety should complete the installation inside the main circuit box (normally outside your house)
- Read all instructions and documentation and save for future reference

#### **Step1 Preparing**

**CAUTION:** Cut off power supply at circuit breaker or fuse before installation to avoid fire, shock or death!






- 1. Remove the wall switch cover plate.
- 2. Disconnect both wires from the wall switch.

Step2 Wiring (standard strip length: 6-7mm)

- 1. Connect Hot Line to "L".
- 2. Connect Neutral Line to "N".
- 3. Connect "I" with "L".
- 4. Connect "O" with load and then with "N".
- 5. Connect "S1", "S2" with external switch separately, and then with "L" .





### Step3 Mounting In-Wall Box

Mount wall switch and cover plate back to the in-wall box.

### **Step4 Restoring Power**

Restore power at circuit breaker or fuse. Installation is complete.

### Operation

#### **INCLUDING the Micro Switch into your network:**

- 1. Set the controller into INCLUSION mode. Follow the instructions provided by the controller manufacturer.
- 2. Press the ON/OFF/PROGRAM button on the Micro Switch.

Note: If the inclusion is successful, the Micro Switch INDICATION LED will be solid on or off depending on switch's state. If not, INDICATION LED will blink slowly.

### **EXCLUDING** the Micro Switch from your network:

- 1. Set the controller into EXCLUSION mode. Follow the instructions provided by the controller manufacturer.
- 2. Press the ON/OFF/PROGRAM button on the Micro Switch.

Note: If the exclusion is successful, the Micro Switch INDICATION LED will blink slowly. If not, INDICATION LED will be solid on or off depending on switch's state.

#### Turning on/off the Micro Switch

The Micro Switch can be controlled by:

- Toggling/pressing external switch/Button.
- Sending commands through controller or gateway. (the command classes which support this function are Basic Command Class, Binary Switch Command Class, and Scene Activation Command Class)

### **Multi-channel control**

The module can be controlled by command "MULTI\_CHANNEL\_ENCAP" in the command class "COMMAND\_CLASS\_MULTI\_CHANNEL".

Refer to "Z-Wave Command Class Specification" for detail information, or consult the information provided by controller/ gateway manufacturer.

### **Multi Channel Association**

To set association groups by the command "COMMAND\_CLASS\_MULTI\_CHANNEL\_ ASSOCIATION".

The module supports 3 association groups. The first two groups are used for switching associated devices (switch N controlling group N), and each group can support up to 5 nodes or terminals. The 3rd association group is used for reporting devices' state to the controller if any changes happen. This group supports one node, which defaults to controller node.

For the first two groups, the touch panel switch will send basic set command to related association groups when setting switch state by gateway or key-pressing. Then the switch states of associated devices and their related key will be synchronic. For the 3rd group, a report will be sent to associated controller by it when any state changes happen in other groups.

#### **Restoring Factory Settings**

The default configuration can be restored by:

 Sending commands through controller or gateway (the command classes which support this function is Configuration Command Class). The parameter are as follows:

Parameter Number	0xFF
Size	1 BYTE
Default value	N/A
Configuration value	0x55

Set 0xFF as 0x55 will restore Factory Settings.

• Pressing and Holding the ON/OFF/PROGRAM button for 15s.

Note: If the Factory Settings is restored successfully, INDICATION LED will blink quickly and then become slower.

- 1. Flush-mount only into a UL/ETL/CE certified plastic junction box and switch panel cover. The minimum size should be 65\*65\*42mm, minimum Volume is 180cm<sup>3</sup>.
- 2. Use Copper Conductors Only.
